Thank you for attending the detour open house for P.I. No. 0007623, the proposed project would replace the deck (superstructure) of the bridge on Moseley Road over Mule Creek in Peach County, Georgia. In this handout package you will find a project description with the proposed detour route, detour/project location map and comment card.

As you enter the room, you will notice displays of the project with the proposed detour route. Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) representatives, who can be identified by the nametags they are wearing, are available to discuss the detour route and answer your questions. Please take this opportunity to discuss the proposed detour route with a GDOT representative. There will be no formal presentation.

A court reporter will be available for those persons who would like to make a verbal statement about the project. You may also complete a comment card and deposit it into the box provided here, or send in written comments about the detour route until June 7, 2013. Written comments should be sent to Mr. Glenn Bowman, P.E., State Environmental Administrator, Georgia Department of Transportation, 600 West Peachtree Street NW, 16th Floor, Atlanta, GA 30308. Comments can also be made via the web at www.dot.ga.gov. Click on **Public Outreach** from the **Information Center** dropdown menu at the top right side of the page. All comments will be made a part of the project record. We hope you will take advantage of one of these opportunities to let GDOT know your view of the proposal.

The displays and plans will be available for review for ten days after the detour open house at the Georgia Department of Transportation District 3 Office located at 115 Transportation Blvd, Thomaston, GA, 30286. A copy of all comments received will be available for public review at this same location and at the Georgia Department of Transportation, Office of Environment Services, 600 West Peachtree Street NW, 16th Floor, Atlanta, GA 30308, as soon as compilation is completed.


Project Description

The proposed project would remove and replace the deck (superstructure) of the bridge on CR 183/Moseley Road at Mule Creek. The total project length is approximately 0.11 mile.

Detour Description

CR 183/Moseley Road will be closed where it crosses Mule Creek for approximately two months and traffic would be detoured away from this location towards an alternate route. Traffic wishing to travel west on SR 183 would be redirected to take Newell Road south for 2.12 miles; then Peach Parkway/SR 49 south for 0.50 mile; Then Bible Camp Road for 2.32 miles; Traffic wishing to travel towards Byron, Georgia would follow the same route in the reverse order. The total length of the signed detour from the CR 183/Newell Road intersection to the CR 183/Bible Camp Road intersection is 4.94 miles.
