Thank you for attending the Public Information Open House for the proposed project along State Route (SR) 20 to improve operations and reduce crash frequency and severity, PI Number 142000-. Our goal is two-fold: 1) to provide you with information on the proposed project and 2) to provide an opportunity for you to give us your comments on the proposed project. In this handout package, you will find a description of the project, a location map, and a comment card.

As you enter the room, please take a look at the project display. Georgia Department of Transportation (Georgia DOT) representatives, wearing nametags, are available to discuss the project and answer your questions. There will be no formal presentation.


Why We Are Here: The purpose of the project is to improve operations and reduce crash frequency and severity on State Route (SR) 20, also known as Loganville Highway. The project would improve portions of SR 20 from a rural major collector to an urban section with curb and gutter.

Project Description: The proposed project is located in eastern Walton County, beginning just north of the intersection of SR 20 with Rosebud Road/Miller Bottom Road and ending at Brand Road in Loganville. The project consists of intersection improvements and a 2.18 mile widening from two to five lanes. The total project length on SR 20 is approximately 5.7 miles.

The SR 20 intersection improvements include intersections at SR 20 and Moon Road, Center Hill Church Road, Centerville-Rosebud Road, and McCullers Road.

State Route 20 is proposed to be widened from a 2-lane roadway to a five-lane roadway beginning south of Sharon Church Road, and would transition from the five-lane section to a one-way pair north of Overlook Drive. The one-way pair will utilize existing SR 20/Main Street as the two northbound travel lanes and Floyd Road (CS) as the two southbound travel lanes. The one way-pair will continue through downtown Loganville until intersecting with SR 81. From SR 81 proceeding north to Brand Road, the SR 20 roadway will be widened from a two lane roadway with a center turn lane to a four lane roadway with a center turn lane transitioning to a raised median prior to Line Street.
