

State Route 284 over Lake Lanier/Chattahoochee River
Project Description

The proposed project is to replace the bridge on State Route 284 over Lake Lanier/Chattahoochee River, 4 miles North of Gainesville. The existing bridge would be replaced with a 952'-0" long by 50'-5" wide bridge. The approach roadway would provide two 12 foot travel lanes, 4 foot bike lanes, curb & gutter, and 12 foot shoulders with 5 foot sidewalks for approximately 2781 ft along State Route 284. A pedestrian culvert will also be added at the north end of the bridge and the west park entrance would be relocated. Traffic will remain on the existing State Route 284 roadway and bridge while the proposed State Route 284 roadway and bridge is being constructed. Traffic will be detoured off-site during the construction of the pedestrian culvert and the associated with roadway construction.
