Thank you for attending the public detour open house for Project BRSLB-1825-00(005), P.I. No. 532320, the proposed bridge replacement of County Road (CR) 309/Radio Station Road/Sunset Road over Little Hurricane Creek in Pierce County approximately three miles southeast of the Bacon County line. The replacement bridge would be constructed on the same alignment as the existing bridge and the roadway would be closed to through traffic. Traffic would utilize an offsite detour during construction. In this handout package you will find a project description, with the proposed detour route, detour/project location map, and comment card.

As you enter the room, you will notice displays of the proposed project with the proposed detour route. Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) representatives, who can be identified by the nametags they are wearing, are available to discuss the detour route and answer your questions. Please take this opportunity to discuss the proposed detour route with the GDOT representatives. There will be no formal presentation.

A court reporter will be available for those persons who would like to make a verbal statement about the project. You may also complete a comment card and deposit it into the box provided here, or send in written comments about the detour route until February 12, 2012. Written comments should be sent to Mr. Glenn Bowman, P.E., State Environmental Administrator, Georgia Department of Transportation, 600 West Peachtree Street NW, 16th Floor, Atlanta, Georgia 30308. Comments can also be made via the web at [www.dot.ga.gov](http://www.dot.ga.gov). Click on **Public Outreach** from the **Information Center** dropdown menu at the top right side of the page. All comments will be made a part of the project record. We hope you will take advantage of one of these opportunities to let GDOT know your view of the proposal.

The displays and plans will be available for review for ten days after the public information open house at the GDOT Waycross Area Office, 104 Nichols Street, Waycross, Georgia, 31501 and the GDOT District Office, 204 N. Hwy. 301, Jesup, Georgia, 31598. A copy of all comments received will be available for public review at this same location and at the Georgia Department of Transportation, Office of Environmental Services, 600 West Peachtree Street NW, 16<sup>th</sup> Floor, Atlanta, Georgia, 30308 as soon as compilation is completed.

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Project BRSLB-1825-00(005), P.I. No. 532320, Pierce County, would replace the existing structurally deficient (i.e., substandard load capacity) bridge with substandard deck geometry on Pierce County Road (CR) 309/Radio Station Road/Sunset Road over Little Hurricane Creek. The proposed project is located in Pierce County between mileposts 2.88 and 3.28 on CR 309/Radio Station Road/Sunset Road, approximately three miles southeast of the Bacon County line, for a total project length of approximately 0.4 mile. The existing bridge over Little Hurricane Creek is 380 feet in length and 25.2 feet in width with two 10-foot travel lanes and no paved shoulders. The proposed road approaches consist of two 11-foot travel lanes, 8-foot graded shoulders including 2-foot paved shoulders, 10-foot front slopes, and 2-foot wide ditches. The new bridge would be constructed on the same alignment and the roadway would be closed to through traffic during construction. Traffic would utilize an off-site detour during construction. The project would require no additional right-of-way and would require construction easements.

The proposed detour route, which would be in effect for approximately 9 months, would consist of traveling on Sunset Road/Beulah Church Road, Jamestown Road, US Route (US) 1/US 23/State Route 4/North Pierce Street/Alma Highway, Corinth Church Road, Radio Station Road, and Blackshear Highway for a distance of approximately 17.4 miles. Signage with directional arrows would be placed along these roads to direct drivers along the detour route.
