


PROJECT DESCRIPTION


Project STP-3711(9), Floyd County is the proposed improvements to SR 101/North 2nd Ave beginning at the Oostanaula River Bridge just south of the intersection of West 3rd Street and North 2nd Ave and ends 650-ft along Martha Berry Blvd just north of the intersection of Turner McCall Blvd and Martha Berry Blvd.

This project proposes to widen and reconstruct the existing 4-lane roadway to include a median with turn lanes. It has multiple intersection improvements such as the relocation of Desoto Ave. A median and turn lanes are proposed at all other intersections within the project limits.

The need for this project is due to the high number of accidents located within the project limits which are caused by high traffic volumes. The purpose of the project is to improve safety by separating the through movements from the turning movements.
